Old Business:

- Ontario winter games have been cancelled. Oakville has been notified

- We are not rescheduling cancelled regular season games; we are moving forward from here.
- University of Guelph, as of January 31st no longer accepting cloth masks. Must use surgical/disposable masks. We need to stress to our players that they get the privilege of playing hockey so please make sure they are wearing masks

- Suggestion is that SCTA starts February 3rd. This gives the kids a few days of practice time before the games start.

Paul H. has asked that we have a consensus that Minor Midget and Midget load everything up on HUDL. Next year there is a fee that we pay for these two divisions to use it. If they don't use it, next year we may have to institute a \$50 fee if games are not loaded. This is a tool that is there to be used. This is for ALL of the kids on ALL of the teams. It makes our whole league better.
