OMHA Updates:

Paul Allan RD:

- Tryouts are finished. We are now into the AA timeframe
- The last OMHA board meeting of the year was on Saturday-Craig Lane will be OMHA President this year. Mark Hooper is the VP of the Western Division, and Craig Berube will be the new RD for Region 2E. Paul will retain his position for the next 2 years.
- OMHA AGM June 11-9:00 am is the business section. Hybrid this year. Make sure that you register. You can log in from home or come to the meeting. There are motions that will be coming forward. Get your delegates in and make sure that you are aware of the motions that are going to be discussed

Old Business:

- The league will be set up in two sections next year. We are asking for a balanced schedule. Play each other at least one home and away before Christmas and then after, a similar type of schedule as you did in the first section.
- HUDL - Not impressed with Customer Service. Reports are erroneous. Staff is constantly changing. Daryl talked to Derek and requested a sit-down meeting. Would like to hear from coaches and managers for thoughts and comments that Daryl can share.
- OMHA Championships-Suggestion, everyone plays 2 games on Friday, 1 on Saturday and quarterfinals, leave Sunday to be only the finals. Daryl sent these suggestions to Derek. Also suggested a tweak to the groups (1-3, 2-4) so that it would be a newer team for them to play. Daryl will send the list of suggestions to Paul Allan for the AAA committee
- Championship Trophies: No response from anyone. STA has 3, Burlington has 1. Please let Daryl know in a separate email if you have any. We will put a line in the budget for the replacement of trophies we cannot find
- SCTA Logo Patch for jerseys. Quote \$2.05/jersey. (Shoulder patch)

- Daryl sent out changes to Tie Breakers:
League Tie Breaker change is that from the seeding after the league play, we have added a line that says that the teams that are tied we will just look at the games that they played against one another. If there is still a tie, then we will look at the whole season

Tiebreakers for Playoffs into OMHA's:

- If two teams are tied a tiebreaker game will be played to determine who goes to OMHA's we will have to play in.
- If three teams are tied, we will follow the 3-way-tiebreaker rules to determine the seeding and eliminate the third-place team. If there is still a tie between two of the teams they will have a play-in game to determine the second and third positions.
- U10 and up are we are looking at having a 32 or 36 game schedule? Possibly 36 for U14 and up. We will look at divisions and teams and determine this next meeting. OHF determines season start dates. AAA starts the first week of October

New Business

- Oakville: Requesting to have an additional AAA team U12 (AA Red) was in a situation where they had very little competition within their loop. Want to provide as many "in town" opportunities as possible for competitive hockey. This team can be competitive at the SCTA AAA level. The second team is 100% Oakville kids, no imports. They will pick their top AAA team as in the past, and will then pick the second team. It has been approved by the OMHA. This is not a permanent proposal; it is a year-by-year situation.
